Part A:- Plan of action chalked out by IQAC in the beginning of the year for quality enhancement and the outcomes achieved by the end of the year.

2008-09

The plan of action of all the academic activities decided is attached herewith as academic calendar of the year 2008-09.

Besides that following tasks were assigned. They were

- ❖ Undertake the scheme 'Earn while you learn" of University of Pune.
- ❖ Persuasion of construction of Ladies hostel building.
- ❖ Organization of 'Past students' meet'.
- ❖ Preparation of RAR report.
- ❖ Organization of camp under 'Samarth Bharat Abhiyan' of University of Pune.
- ❖ Organization of remedial programme for needy students.
- ❖ Commencing the course of B.Ed. through distance mode of IGNOU.

Out come:-

All the activities mentioned in the academic calendar were conducted according to the time table.

In case of the activities mentioned above, the output is as follows-

- ❖ College had implemented the scheme 'Earn while you learn' through out the year. Total 13 student teachers (out of 80) were benefited last year. They earned the money through cleaning the campus, helping in DTP work of the administrative section, keeping record of the books etc.
- ❖ College has achieved the grant for the construction of Ladies hostel building of Rs.30 lakh from UGC XI plan. The plan is of constructing a building which will accommodate 30 lady student teachers. During year 2008-09, after the Bhoomipoojan, construction work started.
- ❖ College could not arrange the 'Past students' meet' during the year 2008-09. Because of the late admissions, newly enforced syllabus and short of two teaching faculty members, it became obligatory for all the staff members to

provide more time for the day today academic work. So it was postponed and now it is arranged on 30th September 2009.

- ❖ LOI is sent to the NAAC officials in Feb.2009.It was accepted and we are asked to send the RAR soon. The preparation of RAR was undertaken in April 2009 and now it is at the final stage. It will be sent to NAAC very soon.
- ❖ It was decided to organize a camp of 10 days in an adopted village. But due to the pressures of academic work, it was further decided that some other activity be taken. So in October 2008, Tree plantation was done in the Amardham of Sukewadi.
- ❖ The remedial teaching programme was arranged after the preliminary examination. Every teacher gave guidance about how to write answers, how to study etc. The concepts which were not clear earlier were explained again.
- ❖ College received recognition as a programme center of IGNOU for their B.Ed. course. (Distance mode.)The first batch of 100 students was inducted in February 2009.
- ❖ The Result of Academic year 2008-09 is also one of the major outcomes.

The result of Academic year 2008-09 of university examination is as follows:-

The Topper amongst the students secured 365/480(76.04%) marks in the university exam.

- ❖ College has started a B.Ed. programme through distance mode by IGNOU. College has got recognition as a programme center by IGNOU. The course is of two years duration. Every year 100 students will be admitted at the center. Counseling sessions, workshops and assignments, practice lessons is the present instructional strategy of this course.

❖ There is a part 'social service' in B.Ed. curriculum. Under this an innovative programme was organized last year in Feb.2009.It was "Let us clean the Pravara river Basin". All the student teachers along with teacher educators went to the river. There was no water in the river at that time. Students collected the garbage from the river basin. Further it was separated into dry and wet garbage. Then it was asked the municipality workers to dump it in the garbage reservoir. The flex boards creating awareness about water pollution were displayed on the riverside.

❖ A blood donation camp was organized in the college in October 2008 with the cooperation of 'Arpan Blood Bank.'.14 student teachers and --staff members donated their blood.

19. Teachers and officers newly appointed::- Shri.Mali N.D. is appointed as a substitute teacher in Jan.2009 against the temporary vacancy of Prof.Murade B.S.

20. Teaching and non teaching staff ratio:- There are eight sanctioned

posts of teachers, one of librarian and one of Principal in the teaching section. In the administration section, according to staffing pattern, there are three posts. One of head clerk, one of junior clerk and the other is of accountant. In this way the teaching to non teaching staff ratio becomes 10:3
