**Part A: - Plan of action chalked out by IQAC in the beginning of the year for quality enhancement and the outcomes achieved by the end of the year, 2009-10**

The plan of action of all the academic activities decided is attached herewith as academic calendar of the year 2009-10

Besides that following tasks were assigned. They were

- ❖ Completion of ladies hostel building.
- ❖ Refresher courses of two eligible staff members.
- ❖ Organization of seminar/workshop with a sponsorship of University of Pune or UGC.
- ❖ Undertaking of at least one major/minor research project by UGC.
- ❖ Preparation of RAR and NAAC visit there after.
- ❖ Continuation of 'Earn while you learn' scheme.
- ❖ Persuasion of M.Ed. course of IGNOU.
- ❖ Organisation of Past students' meets.

Out come:-

All the activities mentioned in the academic calendar were conducted according to the time table.

In case of the activities mentioned above, the output is as follows-

- ❖ Up till now, 90% work of ladies hostel building is complete. Some finishing work is remaining. It will be completed in next two months. Due to scarcity of water in summer, delay in work occurred.
- ❖ This year, two staff members, Dr.S.U.Patil and Shri.Ghadge S.B. have completed their refresher courses.
- ❖ This year one seminar and one workshop were organized. On 1<sup>st</sup> Dec.2009, a seminar on right to information was arranged. Resource persons were from Yashada, Pune. On 28<sup>th</sup> Jan.2010, a workshop on 'Video script writing' was organized. It was sponsored by BCUD, University of Pune. Dr. Ramdas Barakale, a senior and reputed teacher educator was the resource person.

- ❖ One minor research project is sanctioned by UGC in XI th plan. A grant of amount Rs.75, 000/- is sanctioned for this project.
- ❖ A Re Accreditation Report is prepared and is submitted to NAAC in January 2010. College has received its acknowledgement asking the suitable dates after April 2010 and having presence of students. So college has suggested three time slots for the visit and the reply is awaited.
- ❖ . College had implemented the scheme 'Earn while you learn' through out the year. Total 14 student teachers (out of 80) were benefited last year. They earned the money through cleaning the campus, helping in DTP work of the administrative section, keeping record of the books etc.
- ❖ Instead of M.Ed.course of IGNOU, college further had decided to approach to Yashvantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University Nashik, for their M.A. (Education)course.College applied for the same.In response to the application, a committee of YCMOU, visited and validated the information mentioned in the application.
- ❖ Past students meet was organised on 30<sup>th</sup> September 2009.It was limited to the past students from and around Sangamner. In all 20 past students were present. Their needs and expectations from college, were collected through a questionnaire.
- ❖ The Result of Academic year 2009-10 is also one of the major outcomes. The result of Academic year 2009-10 of university examination is as follows:-

As it is rightly mentioned in the mission statement, Institution wants its students to be the pillars of the nation. Therefore the processes, through which this output is expected, are more important. So college never compromises the academic

principles and standards with any thing. There are demonstration lessons of each and every skill and of integration also. Each student conducts each and every practice lesson. There are 8 modules of ICT practical which are conducted in the ICT laboratory. We never mix the practice lessons with internship lessons. Each and every part of the syllabus is implemented with proper care. This becomes helpful for the students to acquire confidence in themselves. Organization of Guest lectures by eminent personalities; help them motivate. Programmes of social service create awareness among the social issues. Through cultural programmes, debating, and discussions they become more and more open minded.

- ❖ College has started a B.Ed. programme through distance mode by IGNOU from 2009. This year a second batch of B.Ed. (2010-12) is admitted in this study center.
- ❖ In year 2009-10, college had applied for the recognition as a study center of M.A. (Edu.) by Yashvantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University, Nashik. The committee members visited the college to validate the information about infrastructure facilities and staff members and were found satisfied. The formal letter of permission is still awaited.

## **7. Initiatives towards Faculty Development Programme:-**

- ❖ The faculty members are allowed to complete the refresher course for their career advancement. This year Dr. Patil S.U. had completed her refresher course in July 2009 in Academic Staff College, Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla. Shri. Ghadge S.B. also completed one refresher course in June 2009, from Nainital University.
- ❖ Faculty members are always encouraged to pursue their research of Ph.D. and also for undertaking minor or major research projects.

This year, three staff members (who possess M.Phil. degree) have started the pre-Ph.D. process set by University of Pune. This year, one minor research project is sanctioned by UGC in XIth plan. It is having a theme about 'Reflective Teaching'. A total grant of Rs.75,000/- is granted for this project and it is to be completed in two years. The investigator for this project is Dr.Bam R.Y.

- ❖ The faculty members are encouraged and allowed to participate in seminars and conferences. They are encouraged for writing research papers and its presentation also.
- ❖ During year 2009-2010, following are the contributions made by the faculty members.

1. **Prin.Dr.N.P.Patil** presented a paper in the conference of MCEAM, held in Chalisgaon. He participated in a seminar on 'Research report writing' in Jalgaon. He had also participated actively in the workshop on 'Right to information' organised by Yashada, Pune. He had participated in a workshop on 'Research methodology' in Moze College of Education, Pune. He had worked as an evaluator of answer papers of preliminary examination conducted by MPSC.

2. **Vice-Prin.Dr.Bam R.Y.** participated in a seminar on B.Ed. curriculum in Tilak College Of Education, Pune. Her research paper on 'Researches in ICT and teacher education' is published in a periodical,"Shiksnatil Marmadrushti". She worked as an editor and writer of a monograph on "Problems of large classes".

She had analysed the video lessons of primary teachers of PCMC schools from Pimpari,Pune and submitted a report on it. It was asked by educational wing of IL&FS,Pune.

A minor research project on reflective teaching is sanctioned by UGC. She worked as an assistant programme in-charge for B.Ed. course of IGNOU.

She had worked as a judge in state level debating competition in PVP College, Pravaranagar.

**3. Dr. S.U. Patil** completed a refresher course in Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla. She had worked as a subject expert for the appointment of faculty of various colleges.

**4. Prof. Ghadge S.B.** completed a refresher course in Nainital. He worked as a guide for M.Ed. students of College of Education, Agaskhind. He delivered a lecture on 'Globalization and Education' in college of Education, Otoor. He worked as a member on LIC committee and a subject expert on interview committees.

**5. Prof. Pithe A.D.:-** worked as a subject expert on various interview committees. He worked as a guide of M.Ed. students of College of Education, Agaskhind. He participated in a seminar on annual college magazine held by student welfare committee University of Pune.

**6. Prof. Kulkarni J.D.-** Awarded M.Phil. Degree by University of Pune, in May, 2009 to her. She worked as a member of LIC committee and subject expert on various interview committees. She participated in a workshop on 'Constructivism' in College of Education, Agaskhind. She also had participated in a workshop on 'Population and adult education in College of education, Dhankawadi, Pune. She took part in training programme on ICT practical in College of Education, Akole.

She delivered a speech in Nutan Madhyamic Vidyalaya, Rajapur, on the occasion of Women's Day.

**20. Teaching and non teaching staff ratio:-** There are eight sanctioned posts of teachers, one of librarian and one of Principal in the teaching section. In the administration section, according to staffing pattern, there are three posts. One of head clerk, one of junior clerk and the other is of accountant. There are in all six posts of menial staff including library attendant. In this way the teaching to non teaching staff ratio becomes 10:9
